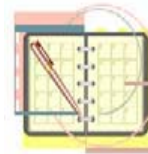

Before and After Care

NBAE's Before and After Care program is still accepting students into the program.

- Before Care starts at 7:00 a.m. and ends at 8:00 a.m. and is \$50 a month per student. Before Care rates do not include breakfast.
- After Care begins at 2:45 p.m. and ends at 6:00 p.m. and is \$160 a month per student.
- Before and After Care is \$200 a month per student.

Note: There is a one time Registration Fee of \$25 for each student

Dismissal Procedures

1. **Children should not be dropped off before 8:00 am** unless arrangements have been made with Before Care. We do not provide morning supervision outside the school.
2. Make sure you have your placard on the windshield of your vehicle prior to pick-up your student(s). You will be asked to park and sign-out your child if you do not have it.
3. **Make sure that all students are picked up by 3:20 pm** unless they are in the After Care program.
4. Dismissal for elementary starts at 2:45 p.m. and the middle school is dismissed at 3:00 p.m.
5. Do not leave your car unattended or use your cell phone while in the car lines.



Note: Students not picked up by 3:20pm will be sent to After Care program and parent/guardians will be billed accordingly.

Volunteer Obligation for 2010-2011

As explained in the NBAE Parent-Student Handbook all parents need to fulfill their volunteer hours for the school year 10-11:

- ⇒ One attending student = 20 volunteer hours
- ⇒ Families of 2 or more attending students = 30 volunteer hours
- ⇒ Half of your required volunteer obligation must be met no later than January 21, 2011, or your re-commit for the 2011-2012 school year will not be processed.
- ⇒ All parents with students in Grades K-7 must be complete their total hours no later than Friday, May 20, 2011. If your total hours are not fulfilled, your child will lose his/her seat for the 2011-2012 school year.
- ⇒ All parents with students in Grade 8 must complete their volunteer hours no later than Friday, April 30, 2011. Failure to meet your obligation will result in your child not participating in the end of the year 8th Grade activities, such as field trips, the end of the year picnic, the Grade 8 Semi-Formal, etc.
