



## Walker Permission Form

Dear Parent or Legal Guardian of a Kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup> grade student,

We understand that many of our students, your children, will be walking to and from our school this school year. Crossing guards are posted in front of the school (to cross 17<sup>th</sup> street) and also at the McNab/81<sup>st</sup> intersection for their safety. Middle school students are allowed to walk home after school with no written or verbal permission from a parent. Parents are reminded that Publix has asked for students to not hang out in the store or parking lot. This permission form is only needed for Kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup> grade students. Kindergarten—2<sup>nd</sup> Grade students ARE NOT allowed to walk home without being accompanied by an approved older sibling or adult. Please list the eligible names on the form below.

The procedure for this process is following:

- 1) Parent Permission (by signing and returning this form, permission is granted)
- 2) Each day, students who are walking home are dismissed first from class
- 3) Walking students will sign-out at the front desk, students who are waiting for older siblings will “hold” in the cafeteria until the sibling meets up with them
- 4) Walking students will walk directly off campus
- 5) Once off campus, students are expected to walk home and only allowed to return in case of emergencies

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I give permission for my son/daughter to walk home from school each day unless I otherwise inform the office. I understand that students that are walking home will sign out at the front desk and are expected to leave immediately at the end of the school day.
